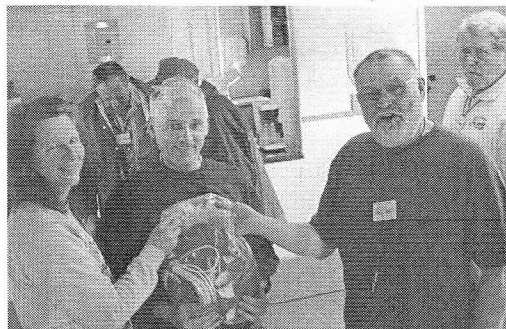


## Nothin' Gray in Grayland!

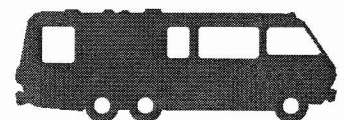

### APPLE FRENCH TOAST

In the bottom of a 9" x 12" pan (or larger), plate 4 to 6 sliced apples.

Add ½ c butter, 1 tsp cinnamon, ½ c raisins, ¼ tsp nutmeg, a small can of apple juice concentrate or ½ of a large can of frozen apple juice concentrate (thawed).

Lay 6 to 8 slices of whole wheat bread over the apples. Mix together 4 large eggs, 2 c milk, and 1 tsp vanilla. Pour over bread slices.

Let set covered, overnight or at least 8 hours. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 45 minutes.
